



2007 Pennsylvania Paint Horse Club Year End Awards Rules

GENERAL: Applies to ALL divisions

1. Owner of the award-winning horse must be a member of the PPHC.
2. Only points accrued after the membership is paid for the current year (received by the PPHC secretary) will count toward year end awards. Memberships may be paid with entry fees at a show for that shows points to count.
3. Awards will be given for individual classes and division high-points.
4. ALL APHA approved shows held in Pennsylvania count toward year-end awards. HOWEVER, to qualify for an award the horse must be shown at least in one PPHC sponsored show after the membership is paid.
5. To qualify for an individual class award the horse must earn a minimum of 12 points - EXCEPTION: Weanlings must earn a minimum of 7 (seven) points.
6. To qualify for a division high-point award the horse must be shown in a minimum of 2 (two) classes in that division. EXCEPTION – Jackpotted Walk Trot
7. No points will be awarded for a particular class if the horse is disqualified for any reason, regardless of the number of horses in the class. The horse is, however, counted as a class entry in determining the total number of class entries.
8. Any ties in the final standings will be broken by counting the number of first places won by the tied horses. The horse with the greater number of firsts is the winner; if a tie still exists, the number of second places, then thirds, etc., will be counted until the tie is broken.
9. Current point standings will be printed in the PPHC newsletter and will be available at every show. Semi-final totals, including division high-points and reserves, will be in the October newsletter. Final standings will be in the November newsletter, with the discrepancies to be resolved by the date indicated.

OPEN DIVISION

1. HALTER
 - A. Individual class awards
 - B. High-point Stallion, Mare and Gelding: Only grand and Reserve awards count. If there is 1 (one) horse in the division, no points will be awarded for Grand or Reserve; with 2 (two) horses in the division, 1(one) point will be awarded for Grand no points for Reserve; with 3 (three) or more horses in the division, 2 (two) points will be awarded for Grand, 1 (one) point for Reserve.
2. ALL AROUND
 - A. Junior
 - B. SeniorAll points received in all open classes, including halter, will count
- C. BREEDING STOCK
All points received in all open breeding stock classes, including halter, will count.
3. 2 YEAR OLD PERFORMANCE HORSE
All points received in 2 Year Old performance classes will count. Halter is not included.

NOVICE AMATEUR & AMATEUR

1. The Amateur/Novice must be a member of the PPHC.
2. The Amateur/Novice must have a current APHA Amateur/Novice Card.
3. Award winning horse must be owned by the amateur/novice or their family as defined in the current APHA Rule Book.
4. Points are kept on a horse-rider combination. If more than one amateur/novice shows the same horse or if an amateur/novice shows more than one horse, points will be kept on each combination separately.
5. High-point Amateur will be awarded to the horse-rider combination with the highest number of total points and Reserve will be awarded to the horse-rider combination with the second highest number of total points. All Amateur classes count, including Amateur Halter.



NOVICE AMATEUR & AMATEUR cont'd.

6. High-point Novice Amateur will be awarded to the horse-rider combination with the highest number of total points and reserve will be awarded to the horse-rider combination with the second highest point total. All Novice Amateur classes will count, including Novice Amateur halter if offered, Amateur halter if Novice is not offered.

YOUTH

1. The Youth must be a member of the PPHC.
2. Award-winning horse must be owned by the Youth or the Youth's family as defined in the current APHA Rule Book.
3. Points are kept on a horse-rider combination. EXCEPTION: Lead-Line and Walk-Trot Points will be kept on the exhibitor.
4. High-Point Youth will be awarded to the horse-rider combination with the highest point total and Reserve will be awarded to the horse-rider combination with the second highest point total in their respective Youth age groups. All Youth classes will count, including Youth halter. If Youth age groups are combined in a class, points will be given in the youth's age group, based on the actual placing in the class.
 - A. Youth 13 & Under
 - B. Youth 14 – 18

OPEN WALK/TROT PLEASURE JACKPOT (PPHC Fundraiser)

1. This division is open to all, \$10.00 entry, jack-potted, with 50% paid back.
2. Points are kept on a horse-rider combination.
3. The horse-rider combination may show walk-trot and a walk/trot-jog/canter-lope class at the same show.
4. The class may be shown Western or English.
5. High-point walk-trot will be awarded to the horse-rider combination with the highest number of total points and Reserve will be awarded to the horse-rider combination with the second highest point total.
