

# Mt. View Paint Horse Shows Year End Award Rules

1. All 8 Mt. View shows count toward year end awards.
2. To qualify for a Year End Class Award, a horse must show to a minimum 6 of the 8 judges. (Except Weanlings)
3. Hi Pt Division Awards will be given to the Youth 18 & Under, Novice Amateur, Amateur, & Open Horse that accumulates the most points. For your points to count toward a hi-pt award you must show halter and at least 3 performance classes within your division to at least 6 of the 8 judges.
4. For Youth 18 & Under, Novice Amateur, & Amateur, one horse one rider combination rule applies.
5. The year end point standings can be viewed at the secretary stand at every show.

## MT. VIEW PAINT HORSE SHOW RULES

1. Hi Point award ribbons will be given for Youth 18 & Under, Novice Amateur, Amateur, and Open. To be eligible you must show in halter and at least three performance classes within your division.
2. Class ribbons 1st through 4th along with grand & reserve halter ribbons can be picked up at the secretary stand.
3. Point charts for the weekend as well as year-end point standings are available to be viewed at the secretary stand.
4. Owners and exhibitors must have a current APHA membership, or purchase a temporary membership before showing.
5. Youth, Novice Amateur, and Amateur's must have proof of eligibility or purchase temporary memberships before showing. Except if only showing in youth lead line or youth walk trot.
6. Bring a copy of your APHA papers and a current APHA membership for the secretary stand to keep on file. (First time showing only)
7. You will be given one back number; this will be your back number for the entire show season.
8. There will be a \$35 charge for all returned checks.
