Minutes from the January 2, 2010 meeting

The PPHC met on January 2, 2010 at Hoss's Steak House in Carlisle, Pa. Vice-President Linda Poole called the meeting to order at 7:20pm.

The first order of business was to discuss the KILE show on October 3, 2010. Linda Poole and Nancy Miernicki reported that they had been in contact with Helene McKernan and the club needs to send a Confirmation of Support email to her. Also discussed was the volunteer help needed from the club, the food stand, if possible and the sponsors needed. Martha Klischer volunteered to manage the food stand. Volunteers were requested from the club and sponsor solicitation was requested.

A treasurer's report was given by Michelle White and approved. The club now has a balance of \$5401.73 in the treasury. This does not include the \$2000.00 set aside for the year-end awards.

In the absence of JoAnn Mullins, the minutes of the previous meeting were read by Tim Rhody. They were approved with one correction. Directors are to be paid \$100 not \$1 toward expenses for attending the National Workshop and Convention.

The yearly banquet will be held on February 6, 2010 at the Lower Allen Township Fire Hall.

At this point Vice-President Poole introduced President-elect Jody Rhody who then took over conducting the meeting. President Rhody gave us a brief biography of herself and introduced her husband. She then gave a short and enthusiastic speech on the need for help and member participation to effect the changes that we need to see in the coming year.

Stephanie Reed will be the webmaster for the PPHC webpage. This was approved by a show of hands.

President Rhody then stated for the need for an organizational budget. She and Michelle White will meet on preparing a budget and present it at the next meeting.

John Gribble reported on fund raising. There are many ideas being explored and will be discussed at the next meeting. Amber Reigel volunteered to help John.

The PPHC facebook page was discussed. This page is owned by Georgia Klischer who stated that she would turn it over to Stephanie Reed to administer if the club desired to continue to use it. She also mentioned some nasty entries had been made. These entries are totally unacceptable. Georgia stated that if the club did not want to use the site to promote club activities, she would just make it a site for Pa Paint horses and continue to monitor it herself. It was voted that Stephanie Reed would run it.

President Rhody stated the meetings will now run by Roberts Rules of Order. This is the basis for all APHA meetings. It was decided that the PPHC would meet on the first Saturday of the month at Hoss's in Carlisle at 7pm. If members would like to eat prior to the meeting please arrive at 6pm in order to start the meeting promptly.

There was a discussion on who to get to make the computer entries at the shows. This will be checked into. Heidi Evelhoch volunteered to keep the points record for the year end awards. She will check with Lori Morris to see if she chooses to continue doing point calculation, would like assistance, or would like to give it up to someone else.

There was much discussion on the upcoming show schedule, classes to be added and deleted, and the switch from futurity classes to stakes classes. Judy Mante' called a show committee meeting following the general meeting and the decisions will be posted soon.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30pm with a motion by Georgia Klischer and seconded by Nancy Miernicki.

Show committee meeting: The following classes will be added for 2010. Youth w/t Showmanship at Halter, Yearling In-Hand Trail, SPB Yearling Longe line. Futurity classes will be replaced by Stakes Classes (these will only be held at our Fall POR) These will be open to regular and breeding stock horses. Non-pro halter (all sexes and ages), Non-pro yearling longe line, Non-pro English and Western Pleasure (all ages), Wcanling (all sexes), Yearling (all sexes), Yearling longe line (all sexes), Hunter under Saddle and a Western Pleasure.

Judy Mante' is adding a payout for the SPB division. \$100 will be divided between the Champion and Reserve Champion at each show. Champion will receive \$60 and Reserve to receive \$40. If only one horse shows, they receive the whole \$100-
